

# The Assignment

The assignment to write this book to the homeless was given to me in the year of 2001. I wrote what God said and afterwards, it was placed in my email storage.

Twenty years later, in June of 2021 after I had come to the end of my writing in another book when God spoke saying. “Bring the book out of storage,” I knew He meant this book and immediately I did that.

On February 16, 2022, after releasing this book it was called back to my computer because God had more to pour, and I left out the main part, the part He had given me from the year of 2001 because I was excited, I released it prematurely. During the years waiting for this book to be completed and released, none of the words that is and was written lost its value.

In December of 2001, the administration of the shelter that was housed in the neighborhood at that time had accepted the invitation from the then pastor of the church for the residence to come to the church and have fellowship time with us. I received the assignment given by the pastor to minister to those in residence.

During the early morning of December 13th (not many days after receiving the assignment), I was laying on the sofa in the front room of my house when I was led by God to my knees to pray, asking Him to tell me what He would have me to say to them that were coming to the church.

When I finished praying, I got up from my knees, sat on the sofa, and instantly my body went into a lean to the right. My body stopped midway in the lean, and there in my ear I heard the word, “**Relationship.**” Instantly I became tired in my body and in my mind and needed to lay down, so I did right there on the couch. At that exact moment I felt the need to sit back up, and I did, at that moment I heard the word again in my mind, “**Relationship,**” but with great emphasis on the word, as though I was being told to pay attention and so I did, and there I heard the words, “**Where You Been, You Can Talk About,**” and there I knew I was in the presence of the Lord, and relationship is the message I was to speak to the people that was coming to the church.

I understood the words God spoke saying, *where I had been I could talk about* from long ago when God was bringing me out of my old way, He told me I had a story to tell but at that time I had no idea what because to me there was nothing worth telling anybody. But as God continued to undo things in my situations I believed. Today I can tell you I have been homeless and without permanent living quarters with all the pain that came with it more times than I cared to remember.

After hearing God speak to me that morning, I realized it was time for me to go to work. I looked over at my kitchen floor, saw that it was dirty, mopped it, and got ready for work. On the El train headed to work, I was able to sit in a seat by the window; that was good for me because I wanted God to talk with me more about what relationships He wanted me to talk about.

I didn't want to draw any attention to myself, there on the El-train so I focused on looking out of the window and up to heaven as if I was admiring the sky, and said to God, inside myself, ...*“Lord Your people need to know the truth. I don't have my Bible with me, but I got enough of Your word on the inside of me to know what You are saying when You speak.”*

When I realized, God was not going to respond back to me there on the train, I relaxed my mind and took my ride to work. When I arrived to work and to my desk, I began to prepare for a busy day of answering phones. I sat down at my desk, and the most unexpected thing happened, Names and stories of people, and their relationships from both the Old-Testament and NewTestament, Bible days flooded my mind! I literally almost fell out of my chair!

I knew inside myself that God had heard my cry on the El train and was giving the message regarding relationships. But something else happened and it changed the entire dynamics of what I was to do with this assignment.

An hour before our visitors were to arrive, the pastor came to me and ushered me to walk with him to his office. As we walked, I noticed he had a strange solemn stiff look about his face even about his walk, as though he was sad and angry at the same time. It was as though he had received some strange, unexpected news, and didn't like what he had heard. But he didn't say any words.

As we entered his office, I stopped mid, his desk, while he stepped to his desk. He began to move his papers around, with his head hanging down, and then he spoke saying, “Things are not going to go the way we planned, no-one will speak, but everyone will sit together at the tables and eat and share their own story with one another.” When pastor had finished his statement, letting me know that I would not deliver the message. I stood still waiting for him to tell me the reason for his decision. I realized he was not going to tell me I became uncomfortable and couldn’t wait to get home to talk to God about it in prayer.

We had a good time at the church that day we sat and shared conversation, just as pastor had said. After our visitors had gone home and I was home I sat down at my computer and went straight into prayer. I said, “God what was that about? Why did you change the plan at the church? I was ready to tell the people what you had given me.” God spoke back, saying, “Write it in the Book.” Just like that. I was in awe!

I looked for scripture in the Bible that would confirm that what I had heard God say, and this is where the Lord led me. Jeremiah 30:1-2. *The word came to Jeremiah from the Lord, saying, “Write thee all the words that I have spoken to you in a book. And that was my confirmation that God had let me know the message regarding relationship was to be placed in a book. I looked to put the message in the book, that I was writing, but the words didn’t fit, none of the words flowed with the message in that book. The words that God had given me on relationship I knew it had been*

given to me for another book- one to come that I didn't yet know about. This is that book.

Now you that have an ear hear what the Spirit of the Lord is saying to you. When God speaks a word, His words does not come back to Him empty, but what He says, goes out and establishes all that He sent it to do. *Isaiah 55:10-11.*

*And that is when and how God begin my journey with you that are homeless to bring this message to you in a book to show you He did not forget you, all He has for you and that He is here with you meeting you where you are to bring you out of all the hinderances in your life.*

*Isaiah 55: 10-11*

*As the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth making it bring forth and sprout giving seed to the Sower and bread to the eater so shall. My word be that goes out from My mouth: it shall not return to Me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I sent it out to do and it shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.*

## Embrace the Vision

The meaning of the word Embrace: an act of accepting or supporting something willingly or enthusiastically, to hug, to hold, to cuddle, to squeeze.

The meaning of the word, Vision: the faculty or state of being able to see; the ability to think about or plan the future with imagination or wisdom.

The Bible read in Proverb 29:18. “Where there is no vision, the people perish; but if the person does have a vision given them and it is embraced, they are made happy.” People of God once you understand that this message is the vision from God for your situation and circumstance, your entire life and that you are to embrace it, that you may have what God is given you, you are on your way to a new way of living.

Listen there will be areas of your life that will be corrected quickly; other areas could take some time. But you will grow every step of the way and the vision written here will come to pass. Though it may tarry wait for it because it will surely come. Again, what you go through in God will grow you. Don't be afraid, you are not alone, God is with you. Stay in the Word of God. Stay in Prayer! Fall in love with Jesus.

This is the word of the Lord for you. “Where you live is not your home and you are not to stay there where you are, come out from where you are, it's not your home and you are not to stay there. God said, the place you lay your head is to be used as a place of restoration to repair the broken places in your life, to stand strong on

your legs and feet and live in a safe living quarters, allowing healthy help from the people He has placed in your life to help repair the wrongful steps that were made against you. For some of you that thing happened before you were born, and some, you were born in a place set to destroy you and left there. And it blinded you and took advantage of you. And many of you are angry at the Lord, you believe He did it to you. Said God, and for some of you God said, it was the sin of them that lived before you that caused your delay.

But I am the Lord, Your God, Says God, and I am here to rescue you- to make you free from the hinderances that has held you hostage. "If you live on the street that is not your home. If you live in a shelter, that is not your home. If you live with someone but your name is not on the lease, that is not your home. Embrace the vision and move forward.

If you were homeless and now live inside someone's else home but you share rent, and take care of your personals, paying your part of the bills, buying your share of food, and it's in a healthy environment, and you work whether you drive or take the bus. It's not your home but you are on you way. Embrace the vision and keep moving forward.

## What's Your Passion?

Let's work from the inside out. Let's get what God is saying to you in your heart. Not the beating one in your chest. No, the heart of your mind. What is your passion, what is it that you believe you are called to do on earth, what is it that you have always desired to do? Don't be afraid. It okay to go here God is with you every step of the way.

Is it to be a minister, a speaker, a teacher, a narrator, a writer, a cook, a chef, baking, nursing, a doctor, to go back to school, what is it that you want to do and or what has God called you to do? What's Your Passion? Think about it. We all have God given gifts to do good and God ideas down on the inside of you. Channel it through your thoughts, and ask the Lord in prayer, "What is my passion God, what did you call me to do. Lord why was I born?" He will show you.

Everything the devil stole from you will be restored back to you, keep listening to what God has said and is yet saying to you here and receive it in your heart both in your will and to do it. God will supply you all that you will need. When God has made a statement from His word/the Bible.

God has already made the way for that statement to go forth and not come back to Him empty but for it to go and get what He has said for you. Therefore, everything sin, injustice, hell, stole from you will be restored back unto you, if you don't give up. Don't give up on God. He won't give up on you.

Now know this, life and death is in the power of your tongue. Proverbs 18:21. So, speak life into your situations and in your circumstances. Do not speak negative words against yourself. If you have accepted the Lord and as your Savior and your Lord and negativity/cursing comes out of your mouth, ask God's forgiveness for you and repent/turn from it quickly. If you have what I call the I can't help it, talk to God in prayer asking Him to heal and deliver from it.

*To ask forgiveness is to be pardon of the sin you committed. To repent means to be godly sorry.*

If you do not know the Lord and have not accepted the Lord, as your Lord and Savior. Say these words. "Father, I don't know the Lord, but I want to know you, it's said that you said God, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. Father I am calling on you right now. Forgive me of my sins Lord. Come into my heart God and save me. In Jesus Name I pray. It's okay. Don't be afraid. God knew the day you would and will come to Him. I'm to tell you this,

There was a man that lived in the Bible days that was born blind, and Jesus and His disciple saw him, and the disciples asked Jesus who sinned that he is blind, did his parents sin, and God answered no one sinned, but its to the glory of God, watch this. God kneeled and took dirt from the ground and spit in and mixed it, Jesus took it and spread it on the blind man's eyes and gave him the instructions to go the river of Shalom and the man went to that water and washed is eyes and when he was done washing, he could see. This is the word of

the Lord for you receive the Lord today in your heart by faith and God is going to let you see that His word is true. Now agree with God and learn what the Bible says and speak life, over your circumstances and over your life, *making it up in your mind, you will live adding Jesus to your words, God I don't know how but I believe you, because your word says You came to give me life, and I want to live in you.* See, although things were kept from you, you got a story, and you need to live. Where you've been you can tell others about it and help them, and as you help others through the love of Jesus Christ, you are being helped, let God bring you into your healing and deliverance in your situations and circumstances.

I didn't understand when God said to me years ago that I had a story to tell and it would help people, but He brought me to understand what it meant and then it helped me, knowing that it was possible. Not everyone will find your story and/or testimony helpful but that's okay, you keep a good heart in Jesus Christ and pray for them—that God sends them who and what they need into their way that they are able to receive the help that you are being given today.

I was homeless and lived in the shelter twice with my children and it was hard in so many different ways. I was confused, my emotions were all messed, the people I met along the way were truly a blessing to me and my children. But the second go round while living in the shelter, coming up to the end of my stay, God blessed me with a new house built from the ground up and I messed up again, coming through that time was a bad time. But I thank God that I had enough of His word

down on the inside of me and was able to remember what I had been given and see the wrong I had done, and how to tell God I was sorry and to forgive me. Each time I was homeless it was for different reasons, and at the same time the same reason. the wrong kind of relationships. I didn't know what a good relationship was; every last relationship I went in, took me into a downward spiral and I was in worse shape coming out than I was going in. But God will take a bad situation that you are in and make it good.

Due to me not knowing what good relationships was, it was much later in my life, but growth came, and I begin to learn about me and to take a good look at myself, and out of that place I learned that I chose people based out of my own rejection, and If you want to know the stuff, request it. Its entitled, "Evolve," and I will do my best in getting it to you.

See, I made the mistake of bringing people into my life just because they were nice or seemed nice, and don't let them look like they had it all together, I wanted them to be my friend for life. I didn't know me. I chose people based on what I believed they could do for me and that led me into a deep place of false humility, lies and deceit, towards them and towards myself. I didn't know me; it wasn't the real me, but it was the me that had been hurt, harmed and rejected. But not only had I been manipulated, mishandled used and abused I had done it to others. Hurting people really do hurt other people, whether they mean to or not. But you don't have to. You can say no to your selfishness and get out of their way with no psychology or reverse- psychology.

There was a time that I trusted people that was not my friend and did not care for me. Understand that is not the way to receive healthy help either. And know when I had gotten a handle on who I was being, verses who I was born to be I knew the change in my behavior, acquired a changed in my mind. And I began to walk in a place, sincerely praying to the Father in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and saying no to the mistakes I had made.

Make the choice today not to be or to become needy, even if you're in need, don't just go anywhere with anybody because of their sweet-sounding words or because they look like they got it all together. It's a place that leads to nowhere. And don't be that one that make people believe you are their one. Slow down learn who you are; take deep breaths, and search down in your own soul. Your soul is you your will/your mindset, your emotions your feelings.

Do your homework, check people out and if it's not working, wait. Don't just attach or connect yourself to people because you don't know who you are, slow down, chill, stop; turn to God and pray to Him, "Help me Lord, who am I?" Who is that person? Seek His counsel.

Everything you and I need to know for our good mind is in the Lord, the word of God, the Bible, that we may move correctly in the way of the Lord. He is the way, the truth and the life. Allow God to answer you, let Him meet you where you are and show you where your change is, and wait there until He directs you from His

word. You will not lose waiting on God. It is a growth process and God knows how to keep you. He will point you in the direction you are to go, and He will show you what you need to know about you and fix you. God really is a heart fixer and a mind regulator. And don't allow an ungodly behavior or to enter your mind because it don't look like things are going to turn out for your good. All things work together the good of them that love God, and called for His purpose, and you defiantly are called, so love God, He loves you. Jesus corrects His children, we don't just do whatever we want to do but His yoke/His correction is easy, and His burdens on us are light. Receiving the correction of the Lord is only trying to your soulish nature because that's the part of us that needs God's healing and deliverance.

Again, God will send people into your situation to help you and at the same time pay attention to the help that come. Not all help is God help. It can look like God's help and not be. Don't be in a hurry to do anything but to pray, submit to God and thank Him for what He has done. Stay prayed up. It may sound contradictory the words I've said but it's not.

Get to know the Lord for yourself, watch and pray, read your Bible. There will be information to contact me at the end of the book to answer your Bible questions; and any questions or concern you have about this book. There is also a part 2 coming, entitled Questions Answered, because there is a correct way to reading and learning the word of God/the Bible.

But until then, only read the new testament, Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Acts, Romans, 1st Corinthians, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1<sup>st</sup> Thessalonians 2<sup>nd</sup> Thessalonians, 1st Timothy 2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy, Titus, Philemon, Hebrews, James, 1<sup>st</sup> Peter, 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter, 1<sup>st</sup> John, 2<sup>nd</sup> John, 3<sup>rd</sup> John, Jude, Revelations, and I will tell you all about those books in part 2 as I'm led by the Lord, And know your Bible read, doesn't have to take all day, but do read it every day. 5mins 10mins, 30 mins.

God speaks to all of us from His word and it's through our relationship with Him that we hear understand and know all that we are to know but it need to be done in the correct manner. Don't allow anyone to stick you in the old testament and leave you there. There is 66 books of the Bible. And do not allow anyone to play with your mind through scripture in order to reach their own interpretation. Part 2 will help you. Allow God to continue ministering to you from the pages of this book. God is a Spirit and they that worship Him must worship Him in the Spirit and in Truth. God the Father, the Word, the Holy Spirit; these three are one.

As God began to prepare me in my own life, and in my own healing and deliverances that I would be fully prepared to do the work He called me to, He added to me another group of people He considers homeless, this people is not necessarily without a physical home though, but at the same time God wants them to receive the same blessing that He has offered to the others listed in the introduction, that they too will hear, learn, and believe Him. This group of people that God speaks on in this chapter is spiritually blinded because they won't believe.

*the scripture directed to you reads,  
In whom the god of this world has blinded the  
minds of them which believe not, lest the  
gospel of glorious gospel of Christ who is the  
image of God should shine unto them.  
2 Corinthians 4:4*

*Now For Clarity.*

*The Easy Read Version of the Bible explains 2  
Corinthians 4:4, this way. The ruler of this world has  
blinded the minds of those who don't believe; (so)  
they cannot see the light of the Good News—the  
message about the divine greatness of Christ. Christ  
is the one who is exactly like God. 2 Corinthians 4:4 –*

This is what happened to some of you and is happening with many of you now because you did not, have not and will not believe God in who He is according to the gospel. You allowed and is yet allowing people that hate God to wrongfully teach you the word of God with their voices and false promises and hidden agenda, in your ears and you believe and follow their way. This is the way of them that you follow. Says God.

    Their ways are always twisted.  
    They think to themselves, we'll never stumble, we'll never encounter any resistance.

    Their mouths are filled with curses, dishonesty, violence. Under their tongues lie troublemaking and wrongdoing.

    They wait in a place perfect for ambush; from their hiding places they kill innocent people; their eyes spot those who are helpless.

    They lie in ambush so they can seize those who suffer! They seize the poor, all night, dragging them off in their nets. Their helpless victims are crushed; they collapse, falling prey to the strength of the wicked.

    The wicked, (that you follow) think to themselves:  
    God has forgotten. God has hidden his face.  
    God never sees anything! Psalm

    10:5-11

The Lord's instructions to me regarding you was to remove the stumbling blocks from your way that you be free to choose Him. God said to me. "Go get them ready that was made blind and held captive by the god of this world. *2 Corinthians 4:4*. It is not righteous. It is not pleasing in His sight. Give the Lord the life that He has and is offering you today. All of You. Where you are living is not your home. The group that you chose to follow is corrupting your good on the inside of you,

*Be not deceive, evil communications, corrupts good manners. 1 Corinthians 15:33.*

I need to take you back to the beginning of the book where I mentioned the morning at my job when God poured out to me the names and stories of a certain people and their relationships, from the Old Testament and New Testament and I almost fell out of my chair, because I just knew He was giving me the message for the people that were coming to the church, that day back in December of 2001, only to find out the message was not for that group of people at that time. But was to be put in the book, that was not yet a book, well, this is that message.

These are real-life stories of real people that lived in the bible days; so you may see, hear, and be corrected, in your mind according to the way of the Lord, because when it comes to your mindset and your behavior you do not understand "Relationship." Said God.

Therefore, God sent from heaven stories of people that lived in the Bible days, to help you- that you may learn

and know right from wrong, good from evil, stay with me God is taking you somewhere and I believe you will enjoy learning it.

### Bible Story 1.

The first story is about a man named David and a woman named Bathsheba and they lived in the Old Testament times. In short there are many different kinds of relationships that comes with the story of David. In short, there was David with Goliath, David with Saul that lived to kill him, then David's friendship with Saul's son Johnathon, but this story is about David's friendship with Joab, the frontline captain in his army, and his relationship with Bathsheba. This story happened in the spring of a year when kings went out to battle; the Bible says, David stayed in Jerusalem, but sent his lead man Joab and his army to fight, and they won the battle.

David rose from his bed and walked on the king's roof, and there from the roof he saw a woman bathing, and the Bible says she was very beautiful to look upon. While David standing there, inquired after the woman. There was one there that knew who she was, saying, "Is this not Bathsheba, the daughter of Elam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?"

David sent messengers for her, she came to David, he took her, and laid with her, and when he was done, she returned to her house. The Bible says the woman conceived, meaning, she was pregnant.

When Bathsheba told David the news that she was with child David sent a message to Joab, the leader of his army of men, saying send me Uriah the Hittite, (Bathsheba's husband), and Joab did as David had said and sent Uriah to him. When Uriah arrived, David demanded that he update him regarding Joab, the people, and how they prospered.

Following this, David said to Uriah go down to your house, and wash your feet, and Uriah left from where David was, but he did not go home to his house but slept at the door of the king's house with all the other servants of the king.

When the men told David, that Uriah had not gone home, David asked him why he didn't go, and Uriah said and I'm paraphrasing for clarity. "All the other soldiers were at the gate, what would I look like going home to lay with my wife and something happened, I will not do that!"

David said to Uriah, "stay here today and tomorrow and then I will let you go," and Uriah stayed there with David. When David called Uriah again, he called him to eat and to drink with him, to make him drunk in hope that he would go home and lay with his wife. But Uriah didn't go home.

When David found out that Uriah had not gone home to his wife, as he had instructed him. The Bible says that David then called Uriah and told him to take a letter to Joab. In this letter, he told Joab to put Uriah on the frontline, to be killed. Joab did as David had said, and Uriah was killed.

David had gone behind Uriah's back to hurt him. First, he approached his wife, taking her, having sex with her, and getting her pregnant; and when he could not cover it up by sending him home to lay with his wife, he had him to carry his own death letter back to the army that he served in, to Joab and had the man killed.

God desire you to walk upright in the relationships that are before you, whether they are family, friend, enemy or foe. An enemy is one that is antagonistic to another especially: one seeking to injure, overthrow, or confound an opponent. Antagonistic is one showing or feeling active opposition or hostility toward someone or something.

*A Foe is an enemy, one who feels a personal enmity, hatred, grudge, or malice against another. It's a person who appears to be close to you and befriends you just to be in the place where they can destroy you and/or your character (A friendly foe) ENEMY: A person who is outright against you and is willing to war with you to dominate you. --*

When the message got to Bathsheba that her husband was dead, she mourned. After her time of mourning, David sent for her, took her home with him and married her. They had a son together, however, when he was born, he was born sick and on the seventh day of the baby's life he died.

God saw what David had done evil and it displeased God. God sent Nathan, (God's prophet,) to show David what he had done and to tell him what God had to say about it. When Nathan spoke to David, he told him

what he had done as though he was talking about someone else.

When Nathan was done telling David what the man had done. David wanted to kill the person, he shouted, saying, "Who would do such a thing! Send for him, this man shall die!" Nathan then told David that it was him that had done the evil and straight out explained to him how he had sinned. When David saw that he had sinned that had committed, he cried, "I have sinned against God," and he sincerely repented to God. This is how Psalm 51 came about when David cried for God's forgiveness.

*Ask God's forgiveness people of God, for your wrong. You have wronged people also, and forgive them that hurt you, all of them. God will help you. Pray the prayer that David Prayed. Have mercy on me O God according to thy lovingkindness: According to the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.*

*For I know my transgressions; my sin is ever before me. Against thee, thee only, have I sinned and done this which is evil in thy sight. That thou mayest be justified when thou speak and be clear when thou judge. Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity; And in sin did my mother conceive me.*

*David cried, "Behold, thou desire truth in the inward parts; and in the hidden part thou wilt make me to know wisdom. Purify me with hyssop, and I shall be clean:*

*Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me to hear joy and gladness, that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice. Hide thy face from my sins and blot out all mine iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God; And renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from thy presence; And take not thy holy Spirit from me.*

*David cried to God, “Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; And uphold me with a willing spirit and then I will teach transgressors thy ways: and sinners shall be converted unto thee. Deliver me from blood guiltiness, O God, You God of my salvation; and my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness. O’ Lord, open thou, my lips; And my mouth shall show forth thy praise. Psalms 51:1-19* David and Bathsheba bore another baby; he lived, was loved by God and his named was Solomon. David being noted in the Bible, a man after God’s heart, not because of his sins but because of his sincere repentance to God for his sins he committed.

Whatever sins you have committed, cry them out to God for His forgiveness for your life. Unrepented sins are hell bound. Repent of the sins you did and know you did, even the wrong that you know you are doing now but don’t know you are in sin. If you know you are in sin but have gotten the “I can’t help it”, ask the Lord to help you. He will help you.

He will forgive you and bring you out of the sin you are in. He will clean you up to where you will not want it again. God will even take the sin that you like and don’t want to give up and cause you to not want it anymore.

Usually when one has gotten caught in sin, the sin has become good to them, and blinded their mind because correction did not come quickly.

## Bible Story 2.

The second Bible story God poured into me, that day at my desk, was the Old Testament story of a husband and a wife, named Abram, and Sari, and the Bible says, And Abram was ninety-nine years old, and the Lord appeared to him saying. “I am the Almighty God; walk before me blameless and I will make my covenant with you and multiply you exceedingly,” and Abram fell on his face and the Lord talked with him letting him know that His promise is with him and that his name and his wife’s name is no longer Abram and Sari but Abraham, and Sarah.”

When the Lord said to Abraham that Sarah would have a son, the scripture says, Abraham fell on his face laughing saying, “Shall a child be born to a man that is a hundred years old and to Sarah who is ninety?”

After God made that promise, the promise didn't come right away, Abraham and Sarah went through some frustrating times, while waiting on that promise. One day, Sarah said to Abraham, and I'm Paraphrasing for clarity. "Abe honey, I'm old and we don't have a baby yet so take my handmaid Hagar and go lay with her and that will be our baby."

Instead of waiting on the promise that God had spoken to him, Abraham went and had sex with Hagar and had a son, but that was not the son that God was talking about to Abraham, and much trouble came from that decision. But God being the God of His word gave them their promised child, and his name was Isaac.

*It wasn't about age with Abraham, and it's not with you. Pay attention to the decision you make inside your relationships if they are wrong, make the decision to right that wrong and walk upright in Jesus. Not making moves to correct your wrong could cause much damage in your life and or your children and or your grandchildren lives to come.*

### Bible Story 3

The next story God gave for you, was inside the life of a man named Samson. Before Samson was conceived and born God chose him to be a judge over Israel to protect them. This story takes us into the relationship with Samson and a woman named Delilah, but much happens before we get there.

Before Samson was conceived the Lord sent an angel of the Lord with specific instructions for his mother to follow while carrying him in her womb, and the Bible

says, “Again, the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord and the Lord delivered them into the land of the Philistines for forty years.”

Now there was a certain man from Zorah, of the family of Danites, whose name was Manoah and his wife who was barren and had no children. An angel of the Lord appeared to the woman and said to her, “Indeed, now you are barren and have no born children, but you shall conceive and bear a son.

Now therefore, please be careful not to drink wine or similar drink and do not eat anything unclean, Behold, you shall conceive and have a son No razor shall be used on his head, the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb until the day of his death and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the land of the Philistines.” the woman came and told her husband saying, “A man of God came to me, and His countenance was like the countenance of the Angel of the Lord; very awesome but I did not ask Him where He was from, and He did not tell me His name. And she told her husband what the Angel of the Lord had said that she is not to drink, or eat anything unclean, while carrying the child and that he will be a Nazirite to God until the day of his death.

Then the woman prayed asking the Lord to send the Man of God back so that He could teach them, what they should do for the child who will be born. God listened to her, and the Angel of the Lord came back as she was sitting in the field, but her husband was not with her. Then the woman ran in haste and told her husband, look the Man who came the other day has just

now appeared, and her husband got up and followed her.

When he came to the Man, he said to Him, are you the Man, who spoke to this woman? Meaning are you the Angel of the Lord that spoke to my wife? And He the Angel of the Lord said, "I am" and the husband said, "Now let your words come to pass! What will be the boy's rule of life and his work?"

The Angel repeated the words to the husband and the husband asked Him to stay so that He may eat. The Angel of the Lord said, "I will stay but I will not eat." So, the woman bore a son and called his name Samson. The child grew, and the Lord blessed him, and the Spirit of the Lord began to move upon him. God had made it so that Samson's strength was in his hair.

Samson became weak for three women, at three different times of his life, a woman from Timnah, whom he married, a harlot/prostitute from Gaza and the third one named Delilah. She was a woman of Sorek, whom he fell in love with, but she did not love him.

In short, Samson's enemies learned of his relationship with Delilah and went to her; made her a proposition to scheme against him to find what makes him strong. Samson's enemies offered Delilah eleven hundred pieces of silver to help them to learn of his strength and to trap him; she accepted it and seduced Samson into telling her all what his enemies wanted to know.

The Bible says Samson told Delilah fabricated lies playing with her back and forth before he told her the

truth about his hidden strength. The Bible says Delilah made Samson fall asleep and called the men to cut off locks of his hair. Samson, too weak to fight, was able to be taken; they took his eyes out and bound him with fetters of brass.

*In short. When the time came, they called Samson out of the prison house to make fun of him because he had killed many of the Philistines. I believe Samson's enemies had not anticipated in their haste that by cutting his locks and making fun of him that his hair would grow back, and he would be strong again, and that is exactly what happened.*

Samson was bound between the brass pillars. A little boy held his hand and Samson asked him to lean him against the pillar so he could feel them, and the boy did what Samson asked. Samson prayed to God to give him his strength back and God did that for Samson, and he regained victory.

But Samson also asked God to let him die there with the Philistines. Samson's life ended that day, and his family came and got him and buried him in his father's tomb. Samson was the Judge for Israel for twenty years.

*Learn who Jesus is, His teaching and His ways; get Him in your heart and you won't make worldly minded decisions that leads you onto an empty path. Trust in the Lord, with all thine heart and do not to thine own understanding, (like Samson did), and God will direct your paths.*

## Bible Story 4

The last story of the Old Testament that God shared with me was about a man named Lot. Together with his wife and their two daughters, they lived in a city called Sodom Genesis 13:12. There were two cities there together, Sodom and Gomorrah.

Lot's two daughters were married; their husbands believed Lot to be joking when he told them it was time to leave Sodom because God was going to go down and burn the city, because they did not believe, they stayed in the city.

When the morning came, the angels of the Lord told Lot to hurry out of the city, or they would be consumed in the punishment of the city. While Lot took his time the angels of the Lord took their hands, showing mercy on him and his family and sat them outside the city, saying, "Escape for your life, unless you will be destroyed." Don't look back.

Lot chose the way they would go into the new town and when they got there safely, God rained down brimstone and fire over the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah. Lot and his daughters entered the new town, but his wife did not. She disobeyed the instruction and looked back, and the Bible says she became a pillar of salt and died.

*There will be places in your life that when God comes to heal, and or deliver you, you, will struggle giving up some things that you like and don't quite want to give up but do not puff up and rebel against God, humble yourself, talk to the Lord, tell Him the truth, thanking Him for His grace and mercy over your life.*

*Jesus will make you whole, taking back everything the devil stole from you. Satan comes to do nothing but to steal, kill and destroy. But God come to give life, and more abundant John 10:1-10*

## Bible Story 5

The New Testament relationship in the Bible that God shared that day back at my desk, is of a certain married woman that had gotten caught in adultery. This woman had truly done the sin, and Jesus knew she had. When the men found the woman, they began shouting off the law concerning her, saying she was supposed to be stoned for that sin.

As Jesus heard them, the Bible says He bent down and began to write on the ground with his finger, and then He stood up and said, "He who is without sin among you let him throw the first stone." Jesus then stooped down again and wrote once more on the ground and the Bible says, those who heard the words that Jesus had spoken, those from the youngest to the eldest threw down their stones and left the woman.

*In short. Jesus stood asking the woman, "Where are your accusers?" They had all gone away. Jesus ministers to the woman telling her to go and sin no more. John 8:1-11*

*Listen, Jesus, hears, sees, and knows all things, He knows how to rescue you from your accusers. Don't be afraid, be quiet amongst your enemies, humble yourself before the Lord. Tell the Lord in prayer about the situation you are in and watch the Lord move on your behalf.*
